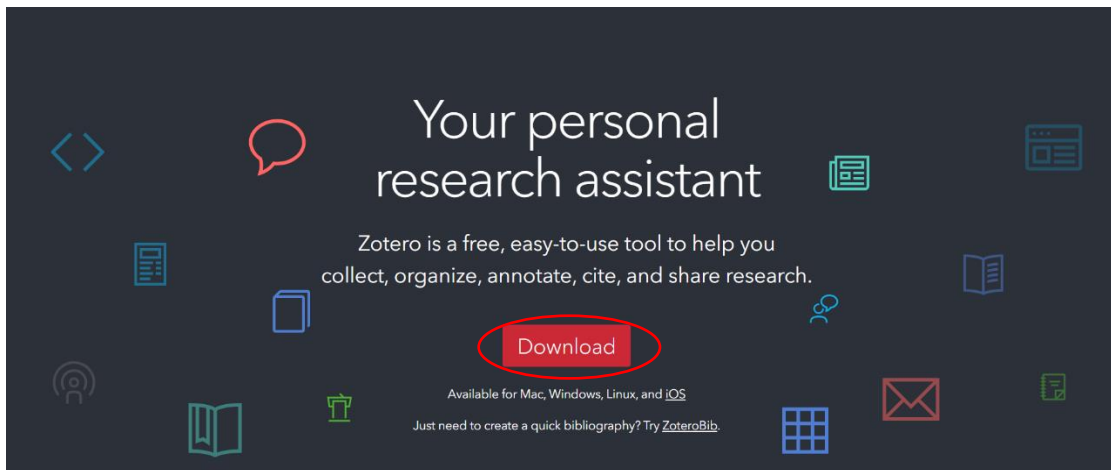


Zotero: Creating an Account

Zotero is a citation and database manager that is free for anyone to install and use. It is compatible with Windows, Mac, and Linux. It helps collect, organize, cite, and share your research. Follow these steps to get started with your own account.

1. Search Zotero on your web browser or go to www.zotero.org. On the main page, there is a red Download button.

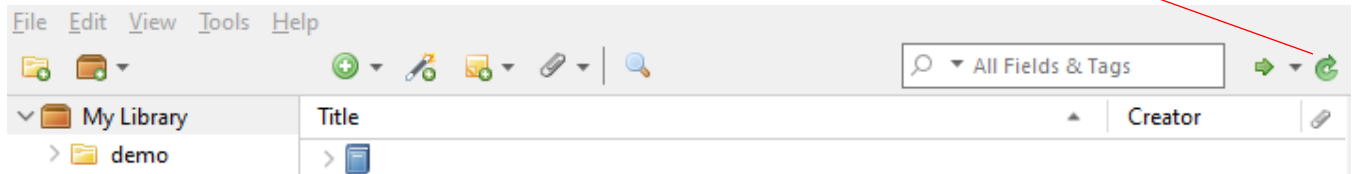


2. This will redirect you to a new page where you can download Zotero for your computer. At this point, also install the Zotero Connector so that you can directly save articles while on Chrome



3. Follow the steps for installation. While this installs, create an account by clicking “Log In” from the top right of the webpage so that you can log in to multiple devices so that your content will sync across devices.

- Once installed, open Zotero and click the sync button on the top right. Sign in with your username and password. Every time you open Zotero from another device, click this sync button to keep your content updated



- You can also access your Zotero library from the web by signing in online to Zotero.org and clicking “Web Library”
