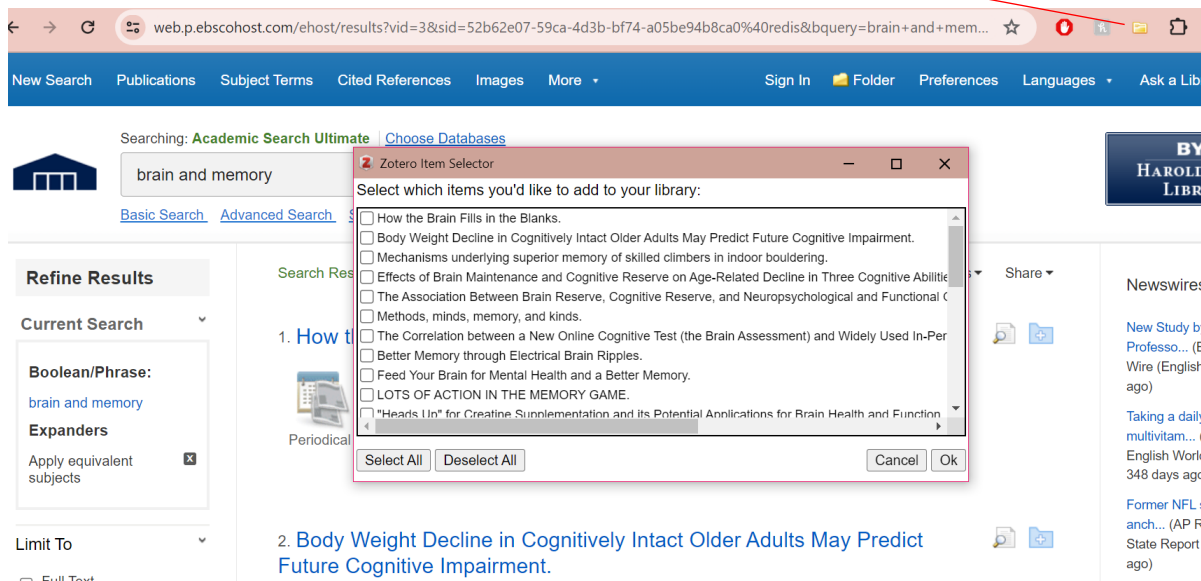


Zotero: Exporting Articles

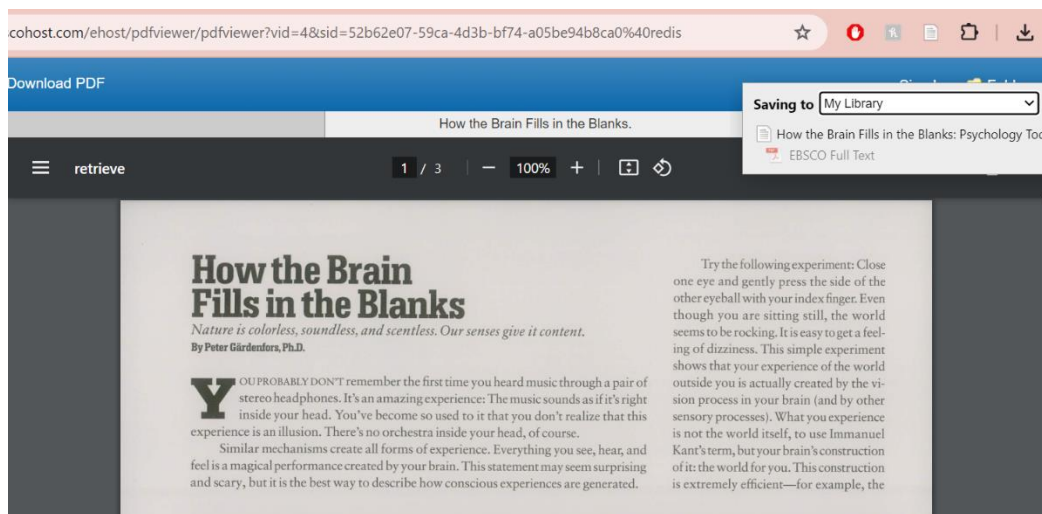
As you find articles that are of benefit to you, it is imperative that you find a way to save them for future reference. Zotero is an excellent option for long-term storage. Despite databases being formatted differently, Zotero can save articles, search results, and websites with one click.

No matter the database or website you are on, if you have the Zotero connector, you should be able to save virtually anything.

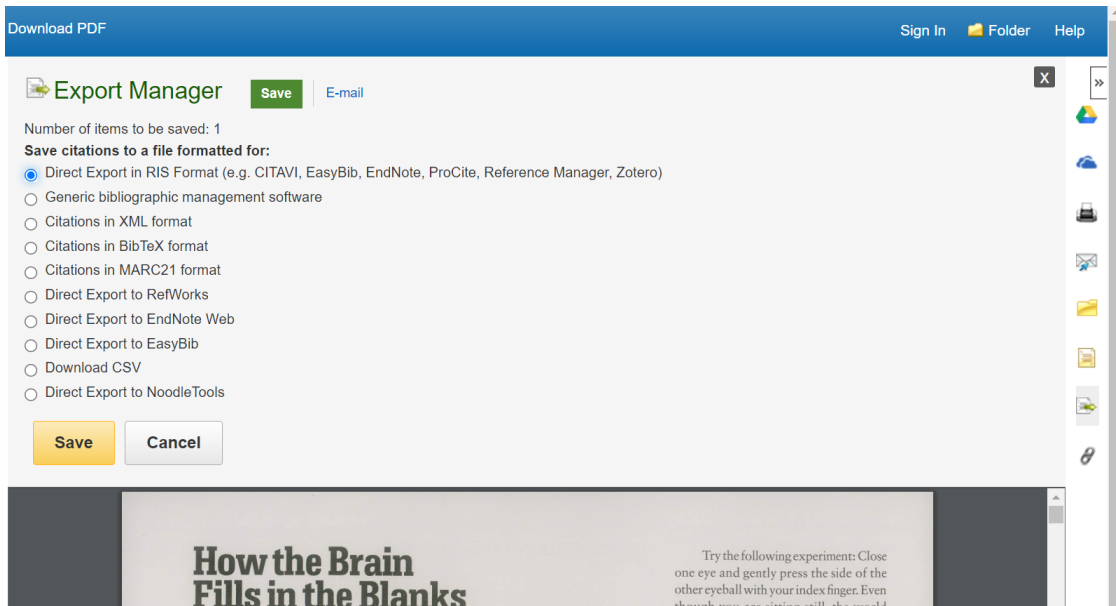
1. While on a database result page, click your Zotero connector to save as many articles on the result page as you want.



2. If on a specific article page, select the Zotero connector to save the individual article and its PDF into your library or a specific collection.



3. Another way to save articles from a database into Zotero, is to download the RIS file. If it's a direct export then it will automatically save into Zotero



4. If it is not a direct export, a file will be downloaded. Import this file by selecting “File,” then “Import” in Zotero
